COMPUTERS - Bah Humbug!

CALLING ABSOLUTE BEGINNERS and OTHERS...



Now for something different!

Two groups are proposed – one for absolute beginners, the second for those who already dabble.

Absolute Beginners Group – no more than 6 members – everything slowly and easily explained. You do not need a computer - you will learn first the important things to know before you even decide to buy. This isn't a college course – it is a down to earth "what and how to do it" group! **<u>Dabblers Group</u>** - up to 10 members - for those who can dabble but need to be able to 'control' their computer and sort it when things go wrong. Ideally you should have access to a laptop (one between two would do).

The purpose of the groups is to make computing enjoyable and easy, so you can find out what they can do for you. You will learn about the Internet and becoming a silver surfer! We will also look at the types of programmes that are available, and even how to purchase a computer that WILL suit both your needs and your pocket. Initially these groups would meet monthly and could run for 6 to 10 weeks (open to suggestion if members wanted more than this).
