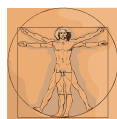

**North Wales Association of U3As Study Day – 14 September 2010, Glyndwr University, Wrexham - by Sue Matthias**

When someone asked me what the study day was about, I exclaimed 'It was great! It was about ... well, stones and rocks, bogs and mosses, heather and hill forts, old industries, ...you know, all that sort of thing'. I found myself unable to encapsulate articulately how wonderfully inspiring it had been. You had to be there. The speakers were all excellent, entertaining experts. Isabel Markham (who had stepped in last minute) brought together geology, history and architecture; Joan Davies showed us the importance of managing landscape from her long experience at Fenn's and Whixall Mosses; Fiona Gale brought to life the ancient hill forts that surround us in this area; and Ray Jones continued with our industrial heritage. **To see the diverse influences of geology, botany, biology, archaeology and history on the natural and built environment was a joy.** I for one will look afresh at this landscape that we take for granted. May I, on your behalf, also give many thanks to the organisers, the genial hosts, Arnold Jones and Derrick Gwilliam, and Glyndwr University for providing an excellent study environment and buffet lunch.
